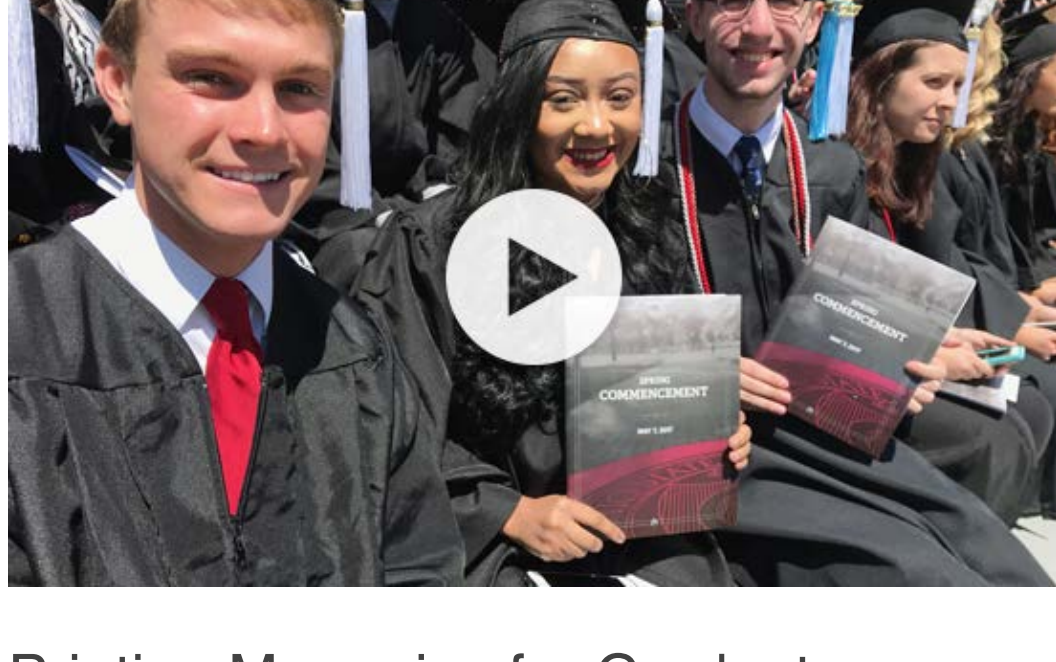


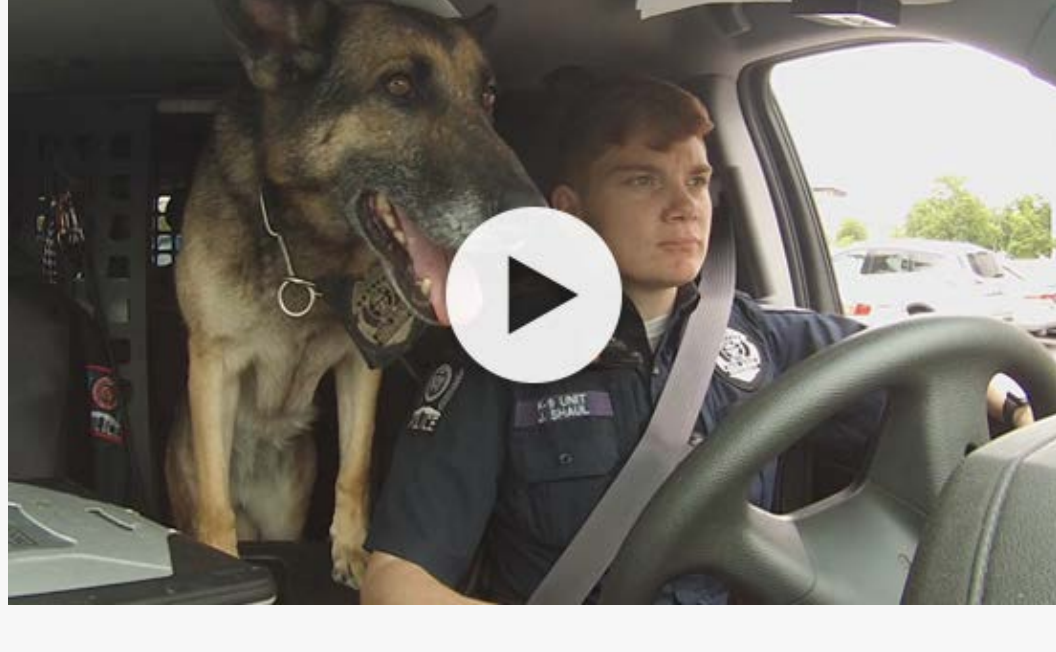

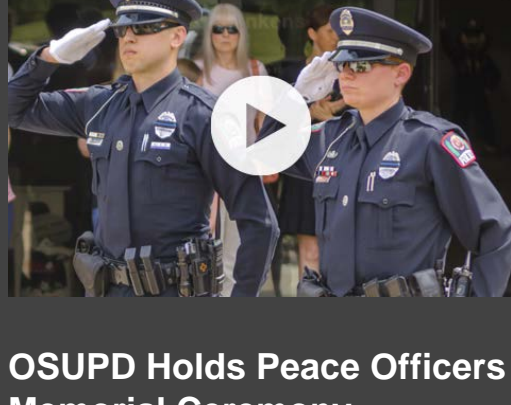
Printing Memories for Graduates

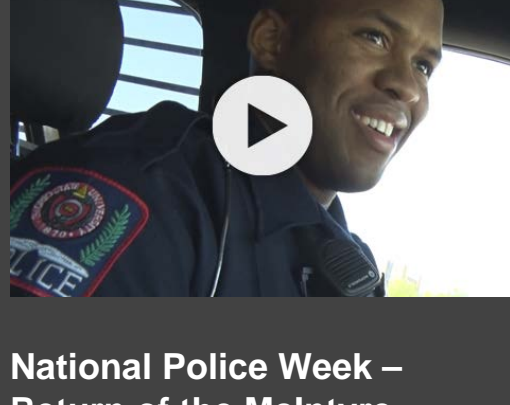
A&People – Officer Joanna Shaul and K9 Rita
